REHEARSAL GUIDELINES

- Rehearsals will be held every Tuesday/Thursday 6-8PM, and Saturdays from 11-1PM.
- It is requested that students not get dropped off more than 15 minutes prior to the start of every rehearsal.
- Students must sign in upon arrival every day. The sign in sheet will be posted on the callboard wall for them.
- Students, please come prepared to sing and dance at every rehearsal. Always have a pencil and your script with you, and be dressed for movement. Bring water or appropriate beverage with you each day as well. No open toe shoes, slip-ons or Crocs. Sneakers or dance shoes are best.
- Please be sure all students eat prior to attending rehearsal. Food will not be permitted in the rehearsal studio. Students can eat before/after/on breaks as needed in the hallway at the counter tops. If there is an extenuating circumstance, please let Sam know in advance.
- All rehearsals are closed. Parents/guardians are asked to gather in the hallway for student pickup at the conclusion of rehearsals.
- If you have any late drop off/early pick up requests, please notify Sam in advance.

ATTENDANCE POLICY

All students will be held to a strict attendance policy. All students will be REQUIRED to complete a conflict calendar prior to auditioning. The calendar will have all rehearsal days and additional events listed on it. Please mark the days you will not be able to attend rehearsal. Conflicts will be taken into consideration during casting. If we encounter any excessive attendance (or behavioral) issues, please be aware the student and family will be notified. In <u>extreme</u> instances, students will be recast or asked to step out of the production.

PTPA YOUTH WORKSHOP STUDENT AGREENNENT

The Pennsylvania Theatre of Performing Arts (PTPA) rules and regulations are designed to ensure that all workshop participants have a fun and safe experience. It is important that all participants abide by the rules. Therefore, we ask that parents and children familiarize themselves with this information. Workshop participants must follow the rules at all times.

(This includes periods when not on PTPA property. i.e. off-site activities)

- 1. Fighting, intimidating, harassing, bullying, foul language, indecent behavior, stealing, tampering with/or destruction of property will not be tolerated. Excessive cases will result in immediate dismissal from the workshop.
- 2. Smoking, the use of alcohol, drugs, firearms, weapons or fireworks are prohibited. Parents will be notified and violators will be sent home immediately. Any case will result in immediate dismissal from the workshop.
- 3. Children are expected to be polite and respectful. Personal space is to be respected as well.
- 4. Children are responsible for their own money and personal items. The PTPA is not responsible for lost items.
- 5. Cell phones must be kept with personal items during rehearsal. They are to be used for emergency situations and should not be out during rehearsal.
- Participants are restricted to the grounds of the PTPA unless written permission is received authorizing the child to leave the premises. This is for the overall safety of all campers. Notification of early pickups and late arrivals must be made in advance.
- 7. Any damage to the PTPA property by workshop participants will be paid for by the participant or his/her parents/guardian.
- 8. Dress Code: Leisure/active clothing is appropriate, however, modesty must prevail and any clothing considered provocative or offensive is prohibited. T-Shirts suggestive of drugs, alcohol, tobacco, or sexual inferences will not be allowed. No flip-flops, backless, or open toed shoes permitted. Sneakers or dance shoes are best. *All students will be participating in dance classes and improv activities, so clothing should allow for free movement.*

PTPA has adopted a three strike policy regarding behavior, bullying, and personal space...

•Strike One: Verbal warning and conversation with parents.

•Strike Two: Sit down with staff, parents and children.

•Strike Three: Student dismissal. No refund.

All those participating in the workshop are expected to follow these guidelines. The workshop administration reserves final judgment on any and all behavior. Those dismissed from workshop due to violations of the agreement are NOT entitled to a refund.
